Daily Disinfecting Checklist

On a daily basis, assess need for regular disinfection of all:

- Play area is clean and free from obstacles
- Furnishings, equipment and play materials are disinfected
- Look for and remove any broken toys or choking hazards
- Medications, herbal remedies and vitamins locked
- Cleaning supplies out of children’s reach
- Pet food out of children’s reach
- Bulletin board current and complete (i.e. menu and activity plans, emergency procedures, fire drill record, childcare first aid certificate, field trip authorization, red door sticker)
- Clean weekly and when soiled: microwaves/fridge/stove, bedding/mats/cribs, garbage containers, toys
- Sidewalks and driveways are free from toys and clutter. Steps and walks are kept free of snow and ice
- Children do not have access to garage or inside vehicles
- Yard must be clean and free from animal feces, hazardous objects, deep holes, broken toys, and equipment, BBQ’s covered.
- Food and dishes are ready to be used
- Play areas and activities (Quiet, creative, dramatic, block,) ready for day
- Clean before and after each use, Kitchen surfaces, tables, chairs/high chairs, plastic bibs, potty eats, plastic diaper change pads, mouthed toys
- Clean daily and when soiled, diaper pails, door handles
light switches, taps, rugs/floors, towels, face cloths and litter boxes
