

## Fluffy Slime Recipe

*Fluffy Slime Recipe Without Borax Made with Shaving Cream*

### Ingredients

- 2/3 Cup White Elmer's Glue
- 1/2 teaspoon Baking Soda
- 1/4 Cup Water
- 2-3 Cups Shaving Cream
- 1.5 tablespoons Contact Lens Solution **\*\*Important:** your brand of contact lens solution must have boric acid and sodium borate in the ingredient list. This is what interacts with the glue to form the slime.
- Liquid Food Coloring

### Instructions

1. Add your white glue to a bowl.
2. Add you water and baking soda and then mix.
3. Add your shaving cream and mix. The more shaving cream you add, the fluffier it will be. You may need to add more contact lens solution if you make it with 3 cups.
4. Add your food coloring until you are satisfied with the color. Mix.
5. Now slowly add in your contact solution.  
**\*\*Important:** your brand of contact lens solution must have boric acid and sodium borate in the ingredient list. This is what interacts with the glue to form the slime. We like [this brand](#) the best. We like to add in 1 tablespoon, knead for 5 minutes and then add in the 1/2 tablespoon after kneading for some time. The slime will be very sticky when you're kneading - and that's normal!
6. If you find it still too sticky - add some baby oil or lotion to your hands. You can also add in more contact lens solution if you still find it too sticky. Just a little bit at a time. We like to add an extra teaspoon at a time until it stops sticking. If you add too much the slime may become too hard and won't be as stretchy to play with.

## Dough Ornaments

### Ingredients

- 4 cups of flour
- 1 cup of salt
- 1 ½ cups of water

### Instructions

1. Preheat oven to 300 degrees F (150 degrees C).
2. Combine the flour, salt and water; mix well and knead for 10 minutes. Roll out on a lightly floured surface.
3. Cut into desired shapes and make holes for hanging. Bake for 30 minutes; allow to cool.
4. Decorate with poster paints or tube paints. Allow to dry and spray with clear polyurethane on both sides to preserve. Use ribbon or yarn pieces to hang.

## No Cook Play Dough Recipe

### Ingredients

- 2 cups plain flour (all purpose)
- 2 tablespoons vegetable oil (baby oil and coconut oil work too)
- 1/2 cup salt
- 2 tablespoons cream of tartar
- 1 to 1.5 cups boiling water (adding in increments until it feels just right)
- gel food colouring (optional)
- few drops glycerine (my secret ingredient for stretch and shine!)

### Instructions

1. Mix the flour, salt, cream of tartar and oil in a large mixing bowl
2. Add food colouring TO the boiling water then into the dry ingredients
3. Stir continuously until it becomes a sticky, combined dough
4. Add the glycerine (optional)
5. Allow it to cool down then take it out of the bowl and knead it vigorously for a couple of minutes until all the stickiness has gone. \* This is the most important part of the process, so keep at it until it's the perfect consistency! \*
6. If it remains a little sticky then add a touch more flour until just right

## Cloud Dough

### Ingredients

- Bin for container
- 5 cups of flour
- 1 cup of baby oil (or cooking oil for tasted safe)
- Play tools

### Instructions

Measure, pour and mix! Add all ingredients to your sensory bin and mix by hand. You should be able to grab a chunk and mold it and have it hold. If not, you may need more oil. Too oily, add more flour! Set it out with your tools and play!

## Moon Sand

What is moon sand? It is a unique but simple mixture of sand, cornstarch and water. It can be packed for great sand castles, formed into mounds and mountains and molded. It stays moist while you play and doesn't harden like clay! I chose to use a package of black colored sand instead of regular play sand for our space sensory play! ***I used about 3 1/2 cups of sand, 1 3/4 cup of cornstarch (all I had) and about 3/4 cup of water.*** You may want to play with the ratios a bit and using regular sandbox sand is just fine! So much fun to make at home!
